

Announcing 2014 OCDA Children's Honor Choir

In conjunction with OCDA Summer Conference at Otterbein College June 16-18. 2014

Dear Colleagues,

The OCDA Board of Directors announces the Seventh Annual OCDA Honor Choir for 150 Ohio unchanged voices in grades 4-8 (current school year). Elementary and Junior High School Music Specialists and community choir conductors are invited to select their finest young singers to participate. Teachers DO NOT NEED TO BE ACTIVE OCDA MEMBERS to recommend singers. Need-based scholarships are available for singers. Forms are available on the OCDA website *www.ohiocda.org* or request one by emailing Tyler Young at mr.tylerjyoung@gmail.com.

Participants will be prepared for the event in five satellite ensembles across the state. OCDA understands and respects time limitations of educators and hopes that many teachers and their singers will be able to take part knowing it will not be an additional strain on their already hectic schedules. The five satellite ensembles will hold two preparatory rehearsals in June 2014. (see registration form for dates and locations in your area) Information and biographies of the satellite conductors is available on the OCDA website (<u>www.ohiocda.org</u>). **Note**: Any teachers willing to prepare their own students are welcome to do so. Please send a separate note indicating your interest in preparing your own students. You will receive information & music once registration materials are submitted.

Dr. Sandra Mathias is a graduate of SUNY - Fredonia (BS in Mus. Ed.); Ball State University (MA with Orff Concentration), The Ohio State University (Ph.D. in Mus. Ed.), and The Kodály Center of America (Kodály Certificate). Dr. Mathias is retired from Capital University, where she served as Professor of Vocal Music Education for 29 years and the Columbus Children's Choir, where she served as Founder/Artistic Director for 25 years. Under her direction, the New World Singers of the Columbus Children's Choir performed at the 2007 national conferences of the American Choral Directors' Association (ACDA) and the Organization of American Kodály Educators (OAKE).

Dr. Mathias is the recipient of the Kodály Institute Intezetért Award, the CSO Community Music Educator of the Year, the Southside Settlement Arts Freedom Award, and Outstanding Educator Award from OAKE. She has presented papers at conferences in the United States, Hungary, Australia, England, Hungary, and China. She is a Past President of the Organization of American Kodály Educators (OAKE). She has served as the R & S Chair for Children's Choirs for OCDA and Central Division of ACDA.

The OCDA Children's Honor Choir Concert will be presented in Otterbein University's Cowan Hall on Wednesday, June 18, at 3 pm. Parents will be able to purchase tickets at the door.

All OCDA conference attendees will receive a concert ticket and will be able to observe Sandy Mathias as she works with the choir. A special offer to observe rehearsals and take part in the summer conference is available as an introductory opportunity for all non-ACDA members that have students participating in the honor choir. (You must have never held an ACDA membership to take advantage of this offer.) Details and forms are available by contacting Tyler Young at mr.tylerjyoung@gmail.com and will soon be available on the OCDA website (www.ohiocda.org). <u>All Honor Choir registrations</u> must be postmarked by April 14, 2014.

I am proud to recommend your child,

for the Ohio Choral Director's Association's 2014

Children's Honor Choir. Children throughout Ohio, in grades 4-7 (present school year) who have been selected by their music teacher, will gather on the campus of Otterbein University in Westerville, Ohio for final rehearsals and concert. Renowned choral director Dr. Sandra Mathias, retired Director of the New World Singers of the Columbus Children's Choir and , will conduct serve as this year's guest conductor. Your child will enjoy working with Dr. Mathias as she prepares a variety of treble choir music.

When

The 2014 OCDA Children's Honor Choir will be in residence on the campus of Otterbein University from June 16th through June 18th Additionally, there will be <u>two mandatory</u>, <u>3 hour "satellite" rehearsals</u> held in five locations throughout the state. (Listed below.)

Where

Satellite Rehearsals -

NW - Bowling Green State University (May 31 & June 7 from 9am-Noon)

NE - University of Akron (May 31 & June 14 from 9am - Noon)

SW - University of Cincinnati (May 31 & June 14 from 9am-Noon)

SE – Ohio University (June 7 & 14 from 9am-Noon)

Central – Capital University (June 7 & 14 9am - Noon)

Final rehearsals/performance – June 16-18, 2014

Otterbein University's Cowan Hall. Children and chaperones will stay in the Otterbein dorms and will dine in the campus cafeteria.

Costs - \$165 Registration Fee will include an Honor Choir t-shirt, room (2 nights) and board (5 meals, Tuesday breakfast thru Wednesday lunch).

Who

150 children from all over Ohio will participate in the Honor Choir. Satellite rehearsals will be led by University Educators/Conductors and Children's Choir Specialists from around the state.

Registration Deadline

Please see your teacher about their specific deadline. They must have all materials by **April 14, 2014**. There is limited space in the choir and registrations are accepted on a first come first served basis. You teacher may choose an earlier deadline in hopes of securing your child's seat in the choir.

When will I hear from OCDA?

OCDA will email you an acceptance packet in early May. In that packet, you may order your concert tickets (\$10.00 each). You will receive an Emergency Medical Form that must be completed and notarized in order for your child to participate. You will also receive directions to your Satellite Rehearsal location and directions to the Otterbein Campus meeting location.

When would my child get the music and t-shirt?

OCDA will give your child the music at the first satellite rehearsal. Each satellite rehearsal will be led by some of Ohio's finest children's choir conductors, to offer this opportunity to your child. Your child will receive his/her t-shirt on June 18th, at registration at Otterbein.

We have a conflict with one of the satellite rehearsals. Can my child still participate? Unfortunately, no.

Your child must be in attendance at each rehearsal (for all six hours) or they will not be permitted to participate in the honor choir. (Exceptions: Child is being prepared by their teacher or parent.) Singers need to come knowing their music so that they can have a positive, successful experience.

What can I do to help?

Chaperone the event at Otterbein University. Please talk to your teacher about this need. <u>Each school must provide chaperones who will be</u> responsible for children from their own school/district. Cost for chaperones is \$100.00 on campus, \$50.00 for those chaperoning students off campus.

Registration Options

Option 1: Teacher does NOT hold a current ACDA membership nor has been a member in the past. If the teacher joins ACDA/OCDA (\$85 for a year's membership – first time member: \$64), then the teacher may attend the OCDA Summer Conference as a guest of OCDA for no additional charge. In order to take advantage of this introductory offer, the teacher must join ACDA by April 13, 2013. (please turn over)

(Membership forms are available online at <u>www.ohiocda.org</u>.) Please send OCDA Honor Choir a copy of your membership application form with this teacher registration form.

Option 2: Option 1, plus the teacher but would also like to stay in the dorm with their singers and eat meals provided by the Honor Choir. Option 2 is an additional \$100.

Option 3: The teacher does not wish to join ACDA or attend the OCDA Summer Conference but will be serving as a chaperone. Room and board during the Honor Choir experience is \$100 chaperone fee. Chaperoning requires the teacher to be with their singers at all times. Teacher choosing this option may not attend summer conference sessions. **Option 4:** The teacher will not chaperone, but will arrange for trusted chaperones to be responsible for their singers while on Otterbein campus.

Option 1 = \$85 (\$64-first time member) mailed to OCDA Treasurer (listed on membership form) + copy of ACDA application form mailed to Sandra Mathias (address listed below)

Option 3 = \$100 for room and board + chaperone form filled out, with teacher listed as chaperone

Option 4 = No cost to teacher, appropriate chaperone arrangements made
