• **Ohio Department of Education** (Ray Lowther)

Lowther made a report as to the state of the Ohio Fine Arts Academic Content Standards. 239 nominations to fill positions as Model Curriculum Writers and as members of the Model Curriculum Advisory Committee have been received. He also reported that there is a strong interest in the field-testing of lessons/curricula by his department.

• **2004 Summer Conference Update** (Gayle Walker)

Walker reviewed the conference activities. We can help by making sure that your name badge is in red and by being helpful to others as a welcoming committee member. Sessions will be timely. All session music will be passed out at registration (beginning of the conference). 118 preregistration at this time which is on track to last year. It was also mentioned that the registration has been raised and that funds are up over past years significantly.

• OCDA Sponsored Workshops/Festivals (Mike Lisi)

Lisi reported 23 attendees at this workshop. A Reading session was included along with a packet of resources generated by Ann Usher. Lisi encouraged us to sponsor other workshops throughout the state. Cost was minimal (at cost) to those who attended. Merrill encouraged the Regional Chairs to sponsor activities to better market OCDA.

• Mileage reimbursement study (Ben Ayling)

Ayling reported that the total round-trip mileage for the Board to Otterbein is 4,734.00. At \$.35 per mile the amount would be \$1,656.90 and at \$.20 it is \$946.80. No action was taken.
